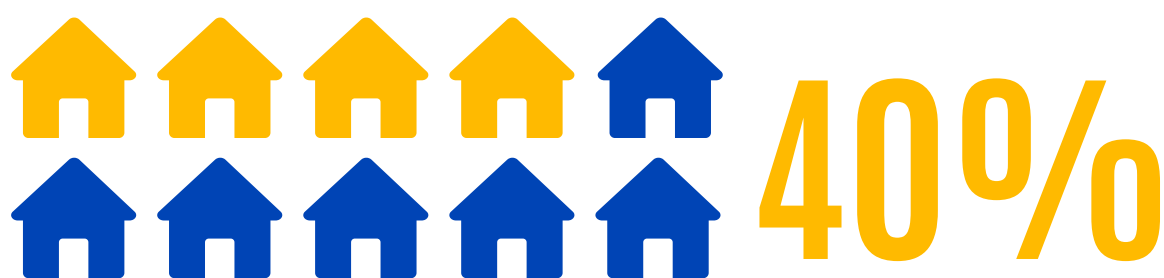

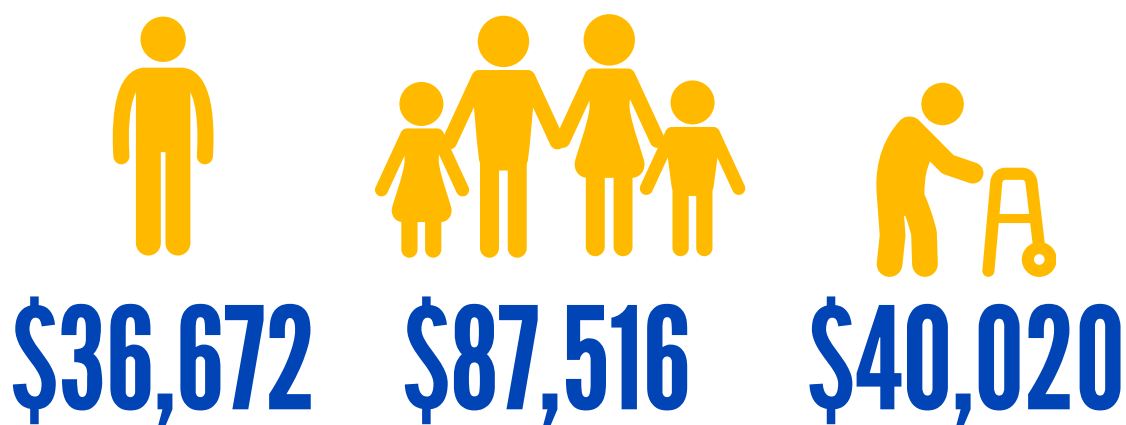


Meet ALICE.
