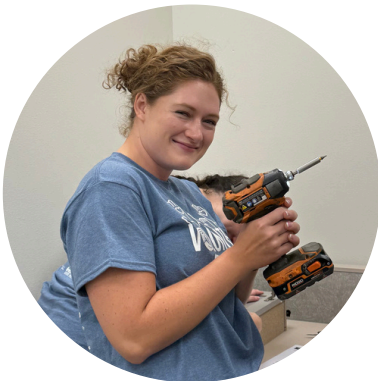
Individual Volunteerism

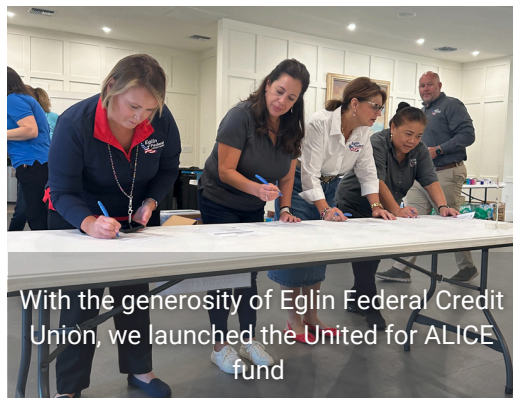

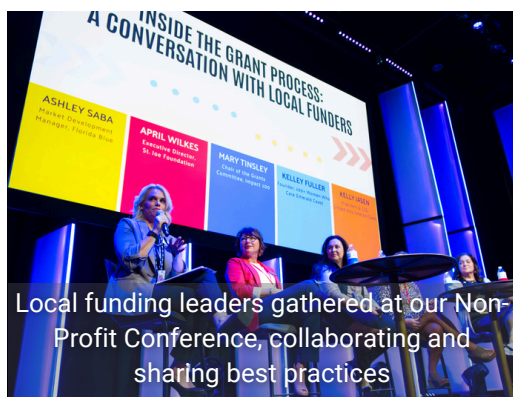

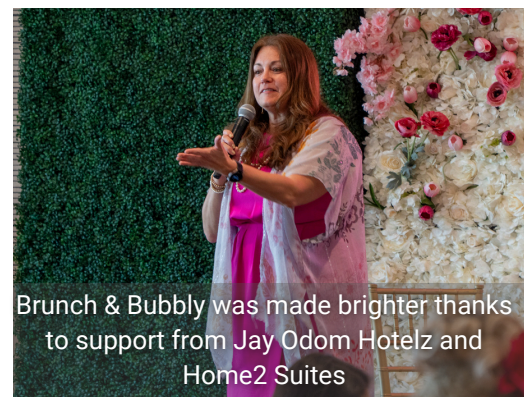
